TURK MAHAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Sherwood Park ACT/UCT Club established a scholarship program for high schools located in Strathcona County in memory of one of our founding members and first president, Turk Mahan. This program provides scholarships in the amount of \$500.00 each, which will be awarded to a student from the graduating class in each school.

The criteria we would like followed for these scholarships are as follows:

1. Must be a grade twelve graduate
2. Must be enrolled in a post secondary or apprenticeship program
3. Should be involved in school and/or community activities
4. Academic standing is less important than school and/or community involvement

We would ask that school administration encourage applications from your student population and select from these applications the three most deserving students for this scholarship program. The finalists would then be submitted to the ACT/UCT scholarship committee for our final selection. Wherever possible it would be preferred that the cheques be presented at the school graduating exercises.
