Ardrossan FAQ Questions

1. What is the first day of school?

• We will be having a staggered re-entry starting September 1st. Regular classes begin. Please follow your schedule on PowerSchool.

Please refer to the below.

September 1st - only 30 level courses (only grade 12 and 11 students that are registered- please refer to your schedule) and Grade 9's

- · (7, 8, 10, 11- unless registered in 30 level class- no classes)
- · Day 1 on student schedule

September 2nd - only 30, 20 Level courses and Grade 8's

- · (7, 9, 10 unless registered in a 20 level course) no classes
- · Day 2 on student schedule
- September 3rd only Grades 7,10,11 and 12
- · (8, 9- no classes)
- Day 1 on student schedule
- · September 4th All students in class
- · Day 2 on student schedule

2. When will the Grade 7 to 9's receive lockers?

All Junior high lockers will be handed out on the first day of school for that Grade (see staggered entry dates) and locker/combinations are on the Parent Student Portal

3. When do I have to wear a mask?

Any person entering an EIPS-operated building or bus must wear a non-medical mask or face-covering unless exempt. The measure also includes all students in kindergarten to Grade 12 when in the classroom and when physical distancing isn't possible. Therefore for the majority of classes, students will be required to wear a mask if a 2 metre distance is not able to be kept.

4. What time can students enter the building on school days?

 The doors to the school will be unlocked at 8:25 a.m.. to discourage loitering in the hallways and common areas. Please do not arrive earlier than that time. Upon entering the building, go directly to your locker and then to your a.m. class.

5. What doors do students use to get into the school?

- · Grade 7- Front Main Doors
- · Grade 8- Band Room and Gym Doors
- · Grade 92 and 95 Front Main Doors
- · Grade 91 and 96 Gym Doors
- · Grade 10- Front Main Doors
- · Grade 11- Elementary side Front Doors
- · Grade 12- Front Main Doors
- · All students driving and Drop offs- Back Courtyard/FishBowl Doors

*****Please ensure that students physically distance and use hand sanitizer upon entry and exiting the school.

*****Students are to access the washroom that is closest to their a.m. or p.m. class only.

6. What will Lunch Break look like?

****Reminder that for the time being that there are no microwaves available.

Grade 7, 8 and 9 students will have designated lunchrooms in a classroom with their core cohort. Grade 10-Learning Commons Grade 11 and 12 -Cafeteria

For the morning session, high school students will be dismissed at 11:30 a.m. and Junior High students at 11:34 a.m.

For the afternoon session, Junior High students will be dismissed at 3:10 p.m. and High School students at 3:14 p.m.

This is to ensure that students clear the hallways, access the cafeteria and embark on to the busses in a physically distanced manner.

Students will be required to eat in their designated lunch room for 15 minutes and then they will be able to access other areas of the school/outside on school property for the last 30 minutes of the lunch period.

Junior High (7-9) students may not leave school property during the school day. If High School students are not scheduled to be in session then they may leave school property and return on time for classes.

7. Will the cafeteria be available to purchase food at lunch?

Cafeteria is slated to open on September 8. Only prepackaged food ie. sandwiches, hamburgers, fries will be served

8. What do I do if I come to school after classes have started? And if leaving for an appointment?

 Please enter the building using the front entrance and proceed directly to the school main office to check in. Also if leaving during the school day, please check out through the office for contact tracing purposes.

9. Can parents drop off materials and lunch for their children during the school day?

Parents/Guardians are not to enter the school unless necessary by appointment/invitation. Families
must access the school through the main entrance, wear a mask and immediately proceed to the main
school office.

Dropping off lunches is currently suspended. If your child forgets their lunch, the school office will contact you to make arrangements.

10. Will I be able to change for Physical Education Class?

• At this point all locker rooms are to remain locked and closed. Students will need to come to PE class changed, proper footwear is required.

11. What about specialty programs?

Specialty programs will continue. In any scenario, Band Class is going to be a performance focused class with a variety of participation based activities. The majority of the time will be spent playing and performing on musical instruments. <u>Creative/General Music</u> would be more accurate titles for Jazz Band in our re-entry.

All of our specialty programs will continue to focus on performance based with extra measures of cleaning and not sharing of food. Teachers will be communicating out their planning for safe and engaging activities and learning.

12. What if my child has a spare class during the day?

Grade 11 and 12 only, Students will be expected to be in the Learning Commons area or off-site.

13. What if I still have textbooks and/or Chromebooks to return from last semester?

Please return these as soon as possible so that new resources can be handed out for this year. A bin will be available for drop off starting Monday, August 24 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
