Key Dates within EIPS

- November 30-December 22: Grades 7-12 students will participate in temporary online learning.
- December 23 to January 5: All students and staff will have the regularly scheduled Christmas break as per the <u>Division calendar</u>.
- January 6-8: Grades 7-12 student will resume temporary online learning
- Monday, January 11: Current in-school learners in grades 7-12 will return to in-school classes

NOTE: None of the measures announced on November 24 affect current out-of-school learners in EIPS—Tracks D and F in PowerSchool. Out-of-school learners will continue with their courses following the existing processes and schedules.

1. What online platform are the teachers using?

All staff and students will be using the Brightspace online platform. Students will require a digital device with a camera and should have received instructions from teachers on how to log on and navigate the learning platform.

This helps parents engage with their young learners and maintain awareness of their upcoming work.

2. What if my student does not have a digital device?

If you require a digital device the school has some student chromebooks available on a first come, first serve basis. There will be a \$300 deposit placed on your Powerschool Parent Portal Account that will be removed once the chromebook is returned in the same condition. There is an agreement form Technology Loan Agreement that will need to be signed and submitted by the parents/guardians to abbey.preston@eips.ca

Please email our Library Technician Ms. Preston <u>abbey.preston@eips.ca</u> if you would like to request a student chromebook. Please provide her with the name(s) of your student and grade level.

3. What schedule is my student following?

Students will be following their current timetable (on Powerschool) and <u>bell schedule</u>. We will have our normal lunch break and then the student will be online for their afternoon class. **Class begins at 8:42 a.m**. and **12:22 p.m**. daily. Please ensure to be on your Brightspace Student page and in the class virtual meet 5 minutes prior to the start class. The meet link will be posted on your Brightspace course page. The purpose of the Meet is to provide meaningful instruction to all students in the class related to the

material or lesson for the day. As needed, teachers can determine if additional, full-class or small-group Meets are needed throughout the class and will communicate times to students as needed, so they know when they are expected to participate.

During the full-class Meet, teachers will provide information and instructions on tasks or assignments for students to complete throughout the rest of the class, as applicable. When the Meet wraps up, students will have time to work on these tasks and assignments for the remaining class time. Each class will also end with a 15-minute, full-class Meet to facilitate an instructional check-in with students and close out the class

4. What are the expectations of our students online?

We expect our students to be fully engaged in their learning just like in the physical classroom. All cameras will be on, so the teacher can see and interact with their students during the lesson. All assignments are to be completed and submitted through the Brightspace classroom.

Etiquette and expectations for online meets is as follows:

- 1. Leave your camera on, mute your microphone when not answering a question, use the Raise your hand feature?
- 2. Do not share the meeting code with any student.
- 3. Inappropriate side conversations / comments will result in omission from the meet and possible further disciplinary action
- 4. Attendance will be taken for each block
- 5. Be safe. Be respectful. Be your best.
- 6. Be aware of your environment while on camera
