Tuition Deposit Reminder

Please remind your students that have received Early Admission to pay their Tuition Deposit!

Students who have received Early Admission are required to pay a non-refundable Tuition Deposit of \$500 in order to register in courses.



Registration is now open to all incoming first year students. Paying the Tuition Deposit and registering in courses at this time will increase the students' chances of building an ideal schedule and securing spots in courses of interest.

Tuition Deposit Information for Aboriginal Students

Third party funded students may be exempt from paying the \$500 Tuition Deposit. Aboriginal students who are receiving third party funding for their education are required to connect with their funding agency (Band, Metis Nation of Alberta, Belcourt Brosseau, Freehorse Family Wellness Society, etc.) to request that documentation of the agency's intention to fund them be sent to the University of Alberta Financial Services Office.

If the student's funding agency is unable to provide documentation at this point in time, the student is still required to pay their tuition deposit and will be reimbursed once confirmation of funding from the funding agency becomes available.

Once the Tuition Deposit payment has been received, the amount will be credited towards the students tuition fee assessment and they will be cleared to register in courses.

New Bilingual Business Administration Program

The Campus Saint-Jean's Centre collegial de l'Alberta (a Center for college-level programming) will launch a bilingual two-year Business Administration Diploma Program (Techniques d'administration des affaires) in partnership with NAIT starting Fall 2014.

The first year of study will take place at Campus Saint-Jean or by distance education and will be offered in French. Second-year students will choose from five specializations offered by NAIT.

The program will be of interest to Francophone, French immersion and Core French high school graduates, to adults in pursuit of professional development or career reorientation, and to newcomers to Alberta.
