

Your students may be eligible for a scholarship!

Participants in the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) or in a Career and Technology Studies Program (CTS) Apprenticeship Pathway may be eligible to apply for a RAP/CTS scholarship from the Alberta Apprenticeship and Industry Training Board.

Students who finish high school this year and are continuing as an Alberta apprentice in a designated trade or occupation may be considered for a \$1,000 scholarship. This scholarship will be available when apprentices attend the technical training component of their apprenticeship.

Students who receive a RAP/CTS scholarship will also be invited to a celebration of RAP/CTS scholarship recipients in Fall 2014 where they will have the opportunity to meet industry leaders and other scholarship recipients.

There are 500 RAP/CTS scholarships available each year.
