Power to Change Next Steps Scholarships	<p>Due date: TBD</p> <p>This year, these scholarships are available to residents of Canada who will be enrolling in a publicly funded post-secondary institution in Canada. A resident of Canada for the purposes of this scholarship is someone living in Canada during the time of application. Applicants must be planning to enter into their first year of an undergraduate program at a publicly funded post-secondary institution in Canada in September 2025 and study full time through April 2026. Only complete applications will be considered.</p>
